The Client:

Local Government & Community Development Department (LG&CDD), Government of Punjab was our client for this assignment. LG&CDD was created to respond to the specific needs of the mega cities and largely urban districts of Punjab for good governance. LG&CDD's functions include: provision, management, operation, maintenance and improvement of municipal infrastructure and services (including solid waste management (SWM)) amongst other administrative functions.



The Project:

Abacus was engaged to conduct a full scope third party evaluation and adequacy assessment of business model and systems at LWMC, followed by strategic recommendations to enhance capacity and performance. AS-IS analysis followed by a TO-BE study based on regional and international benchmarks was conducted, to establish international best market practices in comparable utilities and was used for assessment of Gaps in LWMC's SWM operation. Finally, based on the Gap Analysis, strategic recommendations were made to enhance LWMC's capacity and performance. The assignment spanned 7 distinct modules including:

- · HR and change management
- · Financial management and accounting systems
- · Procurement and contract management systems
- · IT systems and infrastructure
